☀ Purpose	What is the <i>sacred reason</i> this role exists? (Beyond function — what does it serve in the system?)	“To ensure projects deliver lasting value without ethical compromise or burnout.”
☀ Stewardship Commitments	Who are your primary stakeholders? What are your duties toward them?	• Team: Protect wellbeing & clarity. • Clients: Deliver transparency & reliability. • Community: Ensure sustainable methods.
☀ Boundaries & Redlines	What <i>must never</i> be violated in pursuit of targets?	“No project shall exploit or mislead; no team member shall be overworked beyond humane capacity.”
☀ Metrics of Service (Dharmic KPIs)	How will right action be measured — not just output?	• Psychological Safety Index ↑ • Ethical Compliance: 100% • Client Satisfaction Integrity Score (truth in reporting)
☀ Success Horizon	Define <i>legacy measures</i> : what will this role leave behind after 1, 3, 5 years?	“A replicable process that nurtures mindful work and ethical delivery across teams.”
☀ Ritual of Renewal	How will you renew awareness of duty?	Monthly reflection or gratitude circle with direct reports.

Ritual	Timing	Purpose	Simple Script
☼ Morning Intention Round	Daily, start of work	Align consciousness with purpose	“Before we begin, take a deep breath. What one intention will make today’s work a service, not a struggle?”
☼ Gratitude Reflection	Weekly (Friday)	Reinforce appreciation and empathy	“Each of us name one person or act this week that upheld dharma in small ways.”
☼ Kurukshetra Pause	Before any major decision	Restore clarity under moral pressure	“Pause. What is the right action, not just the efficient one? Whom might this harm?”
☼ Earth Offering Ritual	Monthly	Acknowledge ecological interdependence	“We offer gratitude to the land, water, and air that sustain us. What shall we return in equal measure?”
☼ Dharmic Reflection Circle	Quarterly	Collective ethical reflection	“Where did we drift from truth? What will we renew?”

☼☐ Each ritual lasts 5–20 minutes and rewires the organization’s moral reflexes.

✳️ Base Fair Wage	Ethical market rate ensuring equity and dignity.	50–60%	Benchmark vs. region
✳️ Stewardship Bonus	Reward for dharmic contributions (mentoring, ethical leadership, innovation).	15–20%	Linked to Dharmic KPIs
✳️ Community Dividend	Collective share from profit pool distributed by peer review.	10–15%	Measured via Stakeholder Council
✳️ Learning Fund	Dedicated credits for continuous education or spiritual growth.	5–10%	Must show reflective output
✳️ Freedom Credits	Non-monetary time off or flexible work earned through Stewardship Credits.	Variable	Internal ledger record
